

Faversham to prohibit the taking or removing of any shingle or ballast from the shores or banks of the sea at Swalecliffe, between a point opposite the Brook discharging at Swalecliffe Point and the eastern boundary of the Whitstable Urban District (which boundary crosses the foreshore opposite Priest and Sow Corner, Herne Bay-road, Whitstable), being within the said port.

Now the Board of Trade do hereby, by this Order, prohibit the taking or removing of any shingle or ballast from the shores or banks of the sea between the points above mentioned.
