The Board of Trade have received, through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, a copy of a Telegram, dated September 7, from His Majesty's Representative at Alexandria, stating that the Board of Health of that port have made new Regulations with regard to vessels arriving in Egypt, the principal effects of which are: (1) the substitution of five for ten days as the period of observation for ships arriving from plague-infected ports; and (2) the establishment of a possible night visit at Suez of ships from the East.
