His Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs has received a Telegram from His Majesty's Minister at Tokio, dated January 7, to the effect that the blockade of Port Arthur was raised by a Proclamation issued that day.

The Port is closed for the present to all vessels except Japanese Government transports.

Dalny Bay was opened by Special Regulations issued January 6 to Japanese vessels of one thousand tons and over under the conditions named in the Regulations.
