The KING has been pleased to give and grant unto Jules Wilson, Esq., His Majesty's Royal licence and authority that he may accept and wear the Insignia of the Third Class of the Imperial Ottoman Order of the Medjidieh conferred upon him by His Imperial Majesty the Sultan of Turkey in recognition of valuable services rendered by him to His Imperial Majesty.
