Considérant qu'il y a lieu dès lors de confirmer les mesures provisoires prises à l'égard d'Aden,

Arrête :

ART. 1er. Les dispositions qui font l'objet des articles 1er à 4 de l'arrêté royal du 5 avril 1897, susvisé, sont rendues applicables aux provenances du port d'Aden, contaminé par la peste bubonique.

ART. 2. Ces provenances, arrivant par mer, seront soumises, à la station sanitaire de l'Escaut et dans les ports d'Ostende et de Nieuport, ainsi qu'à Selzaete, au régime stipulé par les chapitres II, III et IV du règlement sanitaire général annexé à la Convention sanitaire internationale de Venise, en date du 19 mars 1897.
