

Interpretation.

16. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires—

"Bacon factory" means premises in which the business of a curer of bacon is carried on:

"Slaughterhouse" means any premises where animals are habitually slaughtered:

"Swine-Fever Infected Place" means a place for the time being declared to be infected with swine-fever under any Order of the Board:

"Farm" or "premises" includes two or more adjoining farms or premises in the same occupation:

"Inspector" includes Veterinary Inspector:

"The Board" means the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries:

"The Act of 1894" means the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

Provision as to Existing Orders.

17.—(1.) From and after the commencement of this Order the Area to which the provisions of the Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1903 were applied by the Order

described in the Schedule hereto shall cease to comprise the city of Kingston-upon-Hull, and the restrictions on movement imposed by the Yorkshire (Swine-Fever) Order of 1906 shall cease to apply to the movement of swine from that city.

(2.) The powers of the Local Authority of the city of Kingston-upon-Hull to make regulations under the Swine-Fever Order of 1894, as to movement, exposure, or sale of swine, shall be suspended during the operation of this Order.

Commencement.

18. This Order shall come into operation on the eighth day of August, nineteen hundred and six.

Short Title.

19. This Order may be cited as the KINGSTON-UPON-HULL (SWINE-FEVER) ORDER OF 1906.
