

may arise or be used in the production, generating, use, storage, regulation, transformation, transmission, measurement, distribution and supply of electrical energy under agreement with and for and on behalf of the County Council, and with further powers for the manufacture, fitting up and repairing of any such articles or things and for providing or working material, matter and things for those purposes or any of them, and for doing all things necessary for or ancillary to or which may be conveniently carried on in connection with those purposes or any of them, and generally for other the purposes of the Bill.

4. To authorize the Company on the one hand and the County Council and (in pursuance of any agreement between the Company and the County Council) with any local authority, company, body or person who are or may be authorized (within or beyond the area of supply) to generate, supply or use electricity on the other hand to enter into and carry into effect arrangements and agreements for the transfer to or leasing or working by the Company of their undertaking or undertakings, powers, rights, privileges and obligations in whole or in part, and in connection therewith to authorize the Company to generate, transform, use, distribute and supply electrical energy at and from any generating station or works so transferred to them and within or beyond the limits of supply, or to relieve the Company from obligation to supply electricity from any such generating station.

5. To confer all necessary powers upon the Company and the County Council and any such local authority, company, body or person to enable them to carry out any such agreement or agreements, and to enable the Company to exercise any powers agreed to be transferred to it as aforesaid, and for the purposes of any such supply by the Company to empower the Company to make and maintain all necessary works upon the lands and property of the County Council and any such local authority, company, body or person.

6. To authorize the Company to take and the County Council to grant to the Company a lease at such rent and on such terms and conditions and for such period as may be agreed upon all or any of the lands and buildings and works, including generating stations, mains, machinery, apparatus and things which the County Council have acquired, constructed or provided, or which they are or may be authorized to acquire, construct or provide for the purposes of using, erecting, maintaining and equipping thereon stations, works or things for the generation or distribution of electricity and for any other purposes ancillary thereto.

7. To empower the Company to demand and recover charges for the supply of electrical energy under and for the purposes of the Bill or of any agreement or agreements to be entered into by the Company as aforesaid, and to prescribe or authorize or to make provision for prescribing or regulating the price at which and the terms and conditions upon which such energy is to be supplied, and to exempt the Company from all or some of the obligations with respect to the supply of electrical energy which are imposed upon undertakers under the Electric Lighting Acts.

8. To sanction and confirm any agreement or agreements which have been or which may

during the progress of the Bill be entered into between the Company and the County Council, and any other agreement or agreements with the consent of the County Council between the Company and any body or person.

9. To empower the Company for the purposes herein mentioned to raise capital by means of ordinary or preference shares or stock, and to restrict and regulate the votes of holders of preference shares or stock; to borrow money on mortgage bond or by the issue of debenture stock, and to pay interest out of capital on any shares or stock of the Company, and to lend money on mortgage or bond or otherwise to any local authority, company, body or person, and to guarantee interest or dividend to or the payment of contributions to any sinking fund or loans instalments of and to grant any security by way of rent charge or otherwise in favour of any local authority, company, body or person, and to apply the capital and funds of the Company for all or any of the purposes of the Bill and of any agreement to be entered into by the Company as aforesaid.

10. To authorize and require the Company to repay to the Promoters of the Bills promoted in the Sessions of Parliament 1905 and 1906, under the name or short title of "The Administrative County of London and District Electric Power Company," the costs, charges and expenses incurred in respect thereto.

11. To incorporate with the Bill with or without modification, all or some of the provisions of the Companies Clauses Acts, 1845 to 1889, and especially to modify in their application to the Company the provisions thereof relating to qualification, disqualification, rotation, election, continuance in office and proceedings of and vacancies among directors, general meetings of the Company and votes of shareholders, and to make in regard to such matters and also with respect to the appointment of a managing director such further and better provision as the Bill may prescribe; the Waterworks Clauses Acts, 1847 and 1863; the Gasworks Clauses Acts, 1847 and 1871, and any Acts amending the same; and of the Lands Clauses Acts; and to confer on and extend and apply to the Company and on or to their undertaking, whether with or without exception or variation, all or such of the provisions of the Electric Lighting Acts, 1882 and 1888, and of the schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act, 1899, as may be thought expedient or applicable, and to restrict in their application to the Company all or any of the provisions of such Acts or to limit the area within which the same shall be applicable, and especially to exempt the Company, wholly or partly, from the provisions of the schedule to the said Act of 1899 with respect to the undertakers; prohibition of supply beyond the area of supply; to security and accounts, compulsory works, supply price, electric inspectors, testing inspection, revocation of powers and liability for nuisance, and the provisions of the said Act of 1882 and the said schedule with respect to the breaking up of railways or tramways and roads over bridges and overhead wires, and to vary the provisions of the Lands Clauses Acts with respect to the subscription of capital prior to the exercise of compulsory powers.

12. To vary or extinguish all or any rights or privileges inconsistent with or which would or might interfere with the objects of the Bill and to confer other rights and privileges.
