| JERNINGHAM ROAD, New Cross. | Eight Carriages. On the West side of Jerningham Road, New Cross, by the wall of the playground of Aske's School, at the junction with New Cross Road; horses' heads to face North. |
| BRUCE GROVE ROAD, Tottenham. | Two Carriages. On the North-East corner of Bruce Grove Road, Tottenham; horses' heads facing North. |
| FITZJOHN'S PARADE, Finchley New Road. | Nineteen Carriages. In three portions, viz : First portion :—Eight carriages commencing at North end of Fitzjohn's Parade and extending Southwards along the kerb on West side of Rest, keeping clear of foot-crossing, to end of Triangle; horses' heads to face North. Second portion :—Five carriages by the kerb on East side of Rest, two South and three North of the parish water post, which is to be kept quite clear; horses' heads to face South. Third portions :—Six carriages in Broadhurst Gardens, on North side, by the iron railing enclosing land owned by the Great Central Railway Company; horses' heads to face East. The first portion of the standing is to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion, and the second portion by carriages from the third portion. |
| KNIGHTSBRIDGE ROAD. | Six Carriages. In Knightsbridge Road, in centre of roadway on East side of refuge, opposite Messrs. Harvey and Nicholls; horses' heads Westward. NOTE.—This standing will only be available for three hackney carriages between the hours of 9 A.M. and 7 P.M. daily. |
| SLOANE STREET, Cadogan Place. | Two Carriages. In Sloane Street, at the West end of the enclosure, Cadogan Place Chelsea, commencing at the junction of Cadogan Place; horses' heads Southward. |
| KINGSWAY, High Holborn. | Six Carriages. In the centre of the roadway of Kingsway, commencing immediately South of the refuge at High Holborn, continuing Southwards as far as necessary; horses' heads Northwards. |
| THEOBALDS ROAD, Southampton Row. | Two Carriages. In the centre of the roadway of Theobalds Road, commencing East of the refuge at Southampton Row; horses' heads towards the West. |
| BERKELEY SQUARE. | Twenty Carriages. In two portions, viz. :— First portion :—Fourteen carriages to stand two abreast on the South-East side of Berkeley Square, commencing 132 feet North-East of the drinking fountain, and continuing around the Square enclosure as far as necessary, keeping clear of drinking fountain and entrance gate to enclosure; horses' heads North-East and East. Second portion :—Six carriages, commencing West of the drinking fountain and continuing 112 feet in a North-Westerly direction around the Square enclosure; horses' heads East and South-East. The first portion of the standing is to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion. |
| CROMWELL ROAD, Kensington. | Two Carriages. At the West end of Cromwell Road, Kensington, commencing east of the refuge and extending along the centre of the carriage-way; horses' heads facing West. |
| WYMERING ROAD, Elgin Avenue. | Three Carriages. In Wymering Road, Elgin Avenue, by the dead wall opposite girls' school; horses' heads South-East. |
| UPPER BAKER STREET, Cornwall Terrace Mews | Fifteen Carriages. In three portions, viz. :— First portion :—Five carriages to stand in Upper Baker Street, by the kerb at side of railway wall on North side of the new Tube Station; horses' heads South. Second portion :—Two carriages on North side of Cornwall Terrace Mews, one in front of shelter and one at rear of Urinal; horses' heads West. Third portion :—Eight carriages on the South side of Cornwall Terrace Mews, commencing ten yards from water post by side of railway wall; horses' heads West. The first portion of the standing is to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion, and the second portion by carriages from the third. |
