

KNIGHTSBRIDGE ROAD.	Three Carriages. In Knightsbridge Road in centre of roadway on East side of refuge, opposite Messrs. Harvey and Nicholls; horses' heads Westward.
CADOGAN PLACE, Sloane Street.	Two Carriages. At the South end of the enclosure, Cadogan Place, Chelsea; commencing at the junction of Sloane Street; horses' heads Westward.
THEOBALD'S ROAD, Southampton Row.	Three Carriages. In the centre of the roadway of Theobald's Road, commencing East of the refuge at Southampton Row; horses' heads towards the West.
BERKELEY SQUARE.	Thirty Carriages. In Berkeley Square, commencing at the South-East corner and extending in a Westerly direction around the enclosure as far as necessary.
CORNWALL TERRACE MEWS, Clarence Gate.	Eight Carriages. In two portions, viz. :— First Portion :—Four Carriages on the North side of Cornwall Terrace Mews, Clarence Gate, commencing three feet East of the crossing from Upper Baker Street, and extending Eastwards along the garden railings as far as necessary; horses' heads westward. Second portion :—Four carriages on the South side of Cornwall Terrace Mews, commencing ten yards from water post at corner of Upper Baker Street, and extending Eastwards by the side of railway wall as far as necessary; horses' heads westward. The first portion of the standing is to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.
UPPER BAKER STREET, New Street.	Two Carriages. In the centre of Upper Baker Street, commencing opposite No. 44, and extending Northward; horses' heads to the South.
EARL'S COURT ROAD, Penywern Road.	Seven Carriages. In two portions, viz. :— First portion :—One carriage on the West side of Earl's Court Road, at the South end of the recess outside the exit from Earl's Court Railway Station; horse's head North. Second portion :—Six carriages in centre of Penywern Road, commencing six feet from the crossing at its junction with Earl's Court Road, and extending Westwards; horses' heads East. The first portion of the standing is to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.
ADAM STREET, Strand.	Five Carriages. In the centre of the roadway of Adam Street, commencing ten yards from the foot-crossing at the Strand, and extending Southward as far as necessary; horses' heads Northward.
BLOOMSBURY STREET, New Oxford Street.	Sixteen Carriages. In the centre of Bloomsbury Street, commencing North of the crossing of New Oxford Street, extending Northwards as far as necessary towards Great Russell Street; horses' heads to the South.
THEOBALD'S ROAD, Southampton Row.	Two Carriages. In the centre of the roadway of Theobald's Road, commencing East of the refuge at Southampton Row; horses' heads towards the West.
FOXLEY HATCH ROAD, Purley.	Two Carriages. On the South side of Foxley Hatch Road, one yard West of the public street lamp; horses' heads towards Brighton Road.
STRAND, West of Wellington Street.	Three Carriages. In the centre of the roadway of the Strand, commencing immediately behind the refuge West of Wellington Street and extending Westwards as far as necessary; horses' heads Eastwards. The standing will not be available for hackney carriages between the hours of 10 P.M. and 12 night on account of theatre traffic.
STRAND, Buckingham Street.	Four Carriages. In the centre of the roadway of the Strand, commencing opposite the end of Buckingham Street and extending Westward; horses' heads Eastward.
ROSEBERY AVENUE.	Four Carriages. At Rosebery Avenue, commencing from the urinal inside the Rest, next the kerb, extending in a South-Westerly direction; horses' heads turned North-East.
STATION ROAD, New Southgate.	Two Carriages. On the West side of Station Road, New Southgate, outside Great Northern Railway Station; horses' heads Northwards.
