

TUFNELL PARK ROAD, Fortess Road.	Twelve Carriages. To commence from crossing in Fortess Road and extend along the centre of Tufnell Park Road as far as necessary for twelve hackney carriages to stand; horses' heads towards Fortess Road.
BLOOMSBURY STREET, Great Russell Street.	Two Carriages. In centre of Bloomsbury Street, North of Great Russell Street; horses' heads South.
SPRINGBANK ROAD, Hither Green.	Two Carriages. Next the kerb on East side of Springbank Road, Hither Green, opposite to No. 7, Springbank Market; horses' heads facing South.
ST. JOHN STREET ROAD, City Road.	Three Carriages. In the centre of St. John Street Road, commencing on South side of the refuge at the junction of City Road, and extending South as far as necessary; horses' heads Northward.
FOLEY STREET, Marylebone.	Nine Carriages. In Foley Street, commencing 10 feet from the crossing in Great Titchfield Street, in centre of street to Saville Street.
BASIL STREET, Hans Place.	Three Carriages. On South side of Basil Street, Chelsea, commencing at West end of dead wall adjoining Cadogan Rooms and extending Eastward; horses' heads Westward.
