

civil parishes should be transferred from Hucknall Torkard Sub-District of Basford Registration District to other Sub-Districts of the same Registration District, viz: (a) Bestwood Park Civil Parish to Arnold Sub-District; (b) Bilborough and Strelley Civil Parishes to Beeston Sub-District; and (c) Nuthall and Awworth Civil Parishes to Greasley Sub-District; and (2) that Linby, Newstead, and Papplewick Civil Parishes should be transferred from Arnold Sub-District of Basford Registration District to Hucknall Torkard Sub-District of the same Registration District.

2. Now therefore I, Sir William Cospatrick Dunbar, Bart., C.B., Registrar-General of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers given me by the above mentioned Act, and with the sanction of the Local Government Board, do hereby order and declare that the foregoing alteration shall take effect accordingly.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and seven. Witness my hand this twenty-second day of April, nineteen hundred and seven.
