

TENDERS FOR LOANS ON TREASURY BILLS.

1. The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Cashier's Office, at the Bank of England, on Monday, the 24th instant, at one o'clock, for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Acts 40 Vic., cap. 2, 52 Vic., cap. 6, and 6 Edw. 7, cap. 20, to the amount of £1,800,000, being £500,000 in replacement of the balance of the Bills temporarily paid off on the 15th March, 1907, and £1,300,000 in part replacement of those falling due on the 29th instant.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of £1,000, £5,000, or £10,000. They will be dated the 29th June, 1907, and will be payable at six months after date, viz.:—on the 29th December, 1907.

3. *The Tenders must specify the net amount per cent. which will be given for the amounts applied for, and the Tenders of private individuals must be made through a London Banker.*

4. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

5. The persons whose Tenders are accepted will be informed of the same on Tuesday, the 25th instant, and payment in full of the amounts of the accepted Tenders must be made to the Bank of England not later than twelve o'clock, on Saturday, the 29th instant.

6. The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury reserve the right of rejecting any Tenders.

7. The remainder of the Bills which will fall due on the 29th instant, amounting to £500,000, will not, for the present, be replaced.

MOTOR CAR ACT, 1903.

County of East Sussex.

WHEREAS by sub-section (1) of section 9 of the Motor Car Act, 1903, it is enacted that within any limits or place referred to in regulations made by the Local Government Board, with a view to the safety of the public, on the application of the local authority of the area in which the limits or place are situate, a person shall not drive a motor car at a speed exceeding ten miles per hour:

Notice is hereby given, that the County Council of East Sussex have made application to the Local Government Board for a regulation to be made in pursuance of the said sub-section,

putting the above-mentioned provisions of that sub-section in force within the limits comprising the portion of the main road between the thirty-third and thirty-fourth milestones from London to Brighton, in the village of Handcross:

Notice is hereby further given, that objections to the making of any such regulation may be sent in writing to the Local Government Board at their office at Whitehall, London, on or before the eleventh day of July, 1907.

A copy of any such objection should be sent at the same time by the objector to the County Council, addressed to the Clerk to the County Council of East Sussex, County Hall, Lewes.

ORDER of the Local Government Board:
District Auditor: Assignment of Duties and District:—

MIDDLESEX AUDIT DISTRICT.

To Walter Sutherland Wilkinson, Barrister-at-Law, District Auditor;—

To the Guardians of the Poor of the several Poor Law Unions named in the Schedule to this Order;—

To the Overseers of the Poor of the several Parishes comprised within the said Unions respectively;—

To the Authorities referred to in Article I. (3) of this Order;—

To the Alexandra Park Trustees;—

To the Middlesex Districts Joint Small-pox Hospital Board;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

Whereas by Section 4 of the District Auditors Act, 1879, it is enacted that the Local Government Board may from time to time assign to District Auditors their Duties, and the Districts in which such Auditors respectively are to act, and may from time to time change wholly or in part such Duties or Districts;

And whereas Walter Sutherland Wilkinson, Barrister-at-Law, is a District Auditor duly appointed under the provisions of the Statutes in that behalf:

Now therefore, We, the Local Government Board, hereby certify the appointment to the office of District Auditor of the said Walter Sutherland Wilkinson (hereinafter referred to as "the District Auditor"), and do Order and Prescribe as follows:—

ARTICLE I.—It shall be the duty of the District Auditor to audit the Accounts of the following Authorities and their Officers; namely:—

(1.) The Guardians of the Poor of the several Poor Law Unions named in the Schedule to this Order.

(2.) The Overseers of the Poor of the several Parishes comprised in the said several Unions.
