

after the expiration of each year report to the Board the proceedings taken by the Local Authority under this Order in the preceeding year.

*Powers of Entry.*

6. Any inspector or other officer appointed in that behalf by the Local Authority, and any inspector of the Board, may upon production if so required of his appointment or authority enter any land on which he has reason to suspect that disease exists or has recently existed and examine any gooseberry or currant bush on such land and any person who wilfully obstructs or impedes any inspector or other officer in the course of his duties under this Order shall be liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding ten pounds.

*Notification of Order.*

7. This Order shall be published by the Local Authority by advertisement in a newspaper circulating in the district of the Local Authority or in such other manner as the Local Authority consider best fitted to insure publicity for the same.

*Execution of the Order.*

8.—(1.) The Local Authority of each District mentioned in the schedule hereto shall carry into effect this Order within that District, and shall

appoint such inspectors or other officers for that purpose as may be necessary.

(2.) For the purposes of this Order a notice shall be deemed to be served on a person if it is delivered to him personally or left for him at his last known place of abode or business or sent through the post in a letter addressed to him there, and a notice or other document purporting to be signed by the clerk of a Local Authority shall be prima evidence that it was signed by him and duly authorised by the Local Authority.

*Commencement.*

9. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-second day of July, nineteen hundred and seven.

*Short Title.*

10. This Order may be cited as the GLOUCESTERSHIRE AND WORCESTERSHIRE (GOOSEBERRY MILDEW) ORDER OF 1907.

**ORDER OF THE BOARD OF  
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.**

(DATED 13TH JULY 1907.)

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1903, or of any Order by which such provisions are applied to any scheduled area, swine may be

moved to the exhibition mentioned in the Schedule hereto, and from such exhibition to any place of destination in Great Britain situate in any scheduled area, if accompanied by a Licence authorising such movement.

2. In the case of movement to the said exhibition the Licence shall be one granted by some person authorised in that behalf by the Cardiganshire County Council, and in the case of movement from the said exhibition the Licence shall be one granted by an Inspector of the Local Authority of the District in which the place of destination is situate.

3. The swine shall be moved by the nearest available route and without unnecessary delay to the exhibition or place of destination specified in the Licence and not elsewhere, and while being
