# NORFOLK (SWINE-FEVER) ORDER OF 1907 (No. 5).

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

### Extension of application of Norfolk (Loddon and District) (Swine-Fever) Order of 1906.

1 From and after the commencement of this Order the provisions of the Norfolk (Loddon and District) (Swine-Fever) Order of 1906, herein referred to as "the principal Order," shall apply to the Area described in the Schedule hereto.

#### Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-eighth day of August, nineteen hundred and seven.

### Short Title.

3. This Order may be cited as the NORFOLK (SWINE-FEVER) ORDER OF 1907 (No. 5), and shall be read as one with the principal Order.

# ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

#### (DATED 22ND AUGUST 1907.)

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

### Authorised Exhibition of Fat Swine.

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Swine-Fever (Infected Areas) Order of 1902, and the Order of the Board dated the twenty-fourth day of April, 1907, an exhibition and sale of fat swine may be held at the premises and on the date mentioned in the Schedule hereto, on the following conditions :--

- (i.) The swine must be moved to the exhibition with a Licence under the Swine-Fever (Infected Areas) Order of 1902, which Licence shall be delivered up at the entrance to the sale by the person in charge of the swine to a person appointed by the Local Authority to receive the same.
- (ii.) For the purpose of obtaining the Licence a declaration in the Form set forth in the Schedule to the Somersetshire (Swine-Fever) Order of 1907, with the necessary modifitions shall be sufficient.
- (iii.) The swine exposed at the exhibition may be moved from the exhibition along over or across a highway or thoroughfare in the administrative county of Somerset or the county borough of Bath to any bacon factory or slaughter-hcuse specified in the Licence if accompanied by a Licence authorising such movement—in the Form set forth in the Schedule to the Swine-Fever (Infected Areas) Order of 1902 or to the like effect—granted by the Local Authority of the said county or county borough.
- (iv.) The swine shall before being moved from the exhibition be marked by and at the expense of the owner by the painting, with an indelible composition of red colour, of a broad line down the back and another broad line across the loins of each of the swine, thus +, each line being not less than nine inches long.
- (v.) The Licence shall be in force for not more than four days inclusive of the day of issue.
- (vi.) The swine shall be moved by the nearest available route and without unnecessary delay.
- (vii.) The Licence under this Order for the movement of swine from the exhibition to a bacon factory or slaughter-house shall forthwith after completion of the movement be delivered up at, or sent by post to, the nearest Police Station by the person in charge of the swine at the time of completing the said movement.
- (viii.) The swine shall be detained at the bacon factory or slaughter-house and there slaughtered within five days after their arrival at such premises.

### Attendance at Exhibition of Veterinary Inspector.

2. A Veterinary Inspector of the Local Authority shall attend at the exhibition authorised under this Order.

## Production of Licences; Names and Addresses.
