

**ORDER OF THE BOARD OF
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.**
(DATED 27TH SEPTEMBER 1907.)

(SWINE-FEVER INFECTED AREA).

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Declaration of Swine-Fever Infected Area.

1. The Area described in the First Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be an area infected with swine-fever for the purposes of the Swine-Fever (Infected Areas) Order of 1902.

Revocation of Ryde and District (Swine-Fever) Prohibition of Movement Orders of 1907.

2. The Orders described in the Second Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked as from the commencement of this Order.
