

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows :

Application of Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1903, with modifications.

1. The provisions of the Orders described in the First Schedule hereto shall apply to the county borough of Rotherham, as if it were included in the Schedules to such Orders.

Revocation of Rotherham (Swine-Fever) Orders.

2. The Orders described in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby revoked as from the commencement of this Order.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the thirtieth day of October, nineteen hundred and seven.
