

for any of the purposes of the intended Act, upon the security of their water undertaking or the revenue thereof, the district fund and the general district rate, and any other rates, revenue or property of the Council, or on any of such securities, and to empower the Council to grant and issue mortgages, debentures and stock in respect thereof.

29. To authorize the Corporation to use one form of mortgage for all purposes for which they are for the time being authorized to borrow money, charging the loans upon all or any of the revenues, rates or property of the Corporation.

30. To make further provision with regard to the formation and use of sinking funds, the borrowing and repayment of money by the Council; to empower them to invest all or any of their sinking funds in statutory securities, including securities of local authorities, to use any sinking fund instead of borrowing, to accelerate sinking fund payments and to make provision for equating the periods for the repayment of loans.

31. To alter, amend, extend, enlarge or repeal or re-enact, with or without amendment, all or some of the provisions of the Briton Ferry Gas Act, 1866; the Briton Ferry Local Board Act, 1873; the Neath Water Supply Act, 1861; the Neath Water (Extension) Act, 1865; the Neath Corporation Water Act, 1894; the Briton Ferry Electric Lighting Order, 1901; the Briton Ferry Orders, 1876 to 1905; and all other Acts and Orders confirmed by Parliament relating to the Council, the district, the added area, the Corporation or the borough.

32. To incorporate with amendments all or some of the provisions of the Lands Clauses Acts; the Waterworks Clauses Acts, 1847 and 1863; the Arbitration Act, 1889; the Public Health Acts; the Local Loans Act, 1875; the Railways Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845; and any Act or Acts varying or amending those Acts.

And notice is also hereby further given, that a map in duplicate, showing as well the present boundaries of the district, the boundaries of the borough of Aberavon, and the boundaries of the district and borough respectively as proposed to be altered, will, on or before the said 30th day of November, 1907, be deposited with the undermentioned Clerk at his office in the district, and with the Town Clerk of the borough of Aberavon at his office in the borough.

TEWKESBURY ELECTRIC LIGHTING.

(Amendment of the Tewkesbury Electric Lighting Order, 1905; and Provisions with respect to Transfer of Powers.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade on or before the 21st day of December next by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the borough of Tewkesbury (who are herein-

after called "the Corporation") for a Provisional Order under the Electric Lighting Acts, 1882 and 1888, for all or some of the following amongst other purposes (that is to say):—

To amend the Tewkesbury Electric Lighting Order, 1905 (hereinafter called "the Order of 1905") by extending the periods within which distributing mains are to be laid down within the streets named in the third schedule to the Order of 1905 or otherwise under the provisions of section 21 of the Schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act, 1889, incorporated with the Order of 1905, and by making provision as to the supply of electrical energy to consumers having a separate supply.

To make provision with respect to the transfer by the Corporation of all or any of the rights, powers, duties and obligations and works of the Corporation under the Order of 1905 and the intended Order and the Acts incorporated therewith respectively to a company, body or person (hereinafter called "the Transferee") to be named in the intended Order or any other company, body or person, and to authorize the Transferee or any other company, body or person to exercise and perform all such rights, powers, duties and obligations upon such terms and conditions, and for such period as may be agreed subject to the approval of the Board of Trade, and to confirm and give effect to any arrangement or agreement which may have been or may be made in that behalf.

To authorise the Corporation and the Transferee or any other company, body or person to make and carry into effect agreements for the production, supply and distribution of electricity and the performance of all or any of the Acts incidental to public and private lighting, or the supply of electricity within the area of supply or any part thereof as defined by the Order of 1905.
