

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Handsworth Rectory Act, 1891, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Saint Michael, Handsworth, in the county of Stafford, and in the diocese of Birmingham, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, one yearly sum or stipend of fifty pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the Handsworth Rectory Account in accordance with the provisions of the said Act, and to be calculated as from the first day of May, in the year one thousand nine hundred and seven, and to be receivable in equal quarterly portions on the twenty-fifth day of March, the twenty-fourth day of June, the twenty-ninth day of September, and the twenty-fifth day of December in each and every year: Provided that the yearly sum hereby granted is in case of deficiency of income subject to abatement in accordance with the provisions of the said Act.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction of a capital sum of nine hundred and two pounds and sixpence, which has been paid to us in favour of the vicarage of Lyme Regis, in the county of Dorset, and in the diocese of Salisbury, and in respect of which we have agreed to pay to the Incumbent of the same vicarage, and to his successors, a yearly sum of twenty-seven pounds and one shilling, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, grant out of our common fund to the said vicarage of Lyme Regis, to meet such benefaction, one capital sum of eight hundred pounds, in respect of which, so long as the same capital sum or any part thereof shall remain in our hands, there shall be paid by us to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage one yearly sum of twenty-four pounds, or such part thereof as shall be proportionate to any balance of the same capital sum which shall so remain in our hands; the above-mentioned yearly payments to commence as from the ninth day of November, in the year one thousand nine hundred and seven, and to be receivable in equal quarterly portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and on the first day of November in each and every year.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Minister or Incumbent of the district and benefice of Saint Stephen, Norbury, in the county of Surrey, and in the diocese of Canterbury, and to his successors, Ministers or Incumbents of the same district and benefice, one yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and fifty pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our

control, and to be calculated as from the eighth day of November, in the year one thousand nine hundred and seven, and to be receivable in equal quarterly portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and the first day of November, in each and every year: Provided always, that if at any time lands, tithes, or other hereditaments sufficient in our opinion to produce the said yearly sum or stipend, or any part thereof, shall be annexed by us to the said district and benefice of Saint Stephen, Norbury, in substitution for such yearly sum or stipend, or for such part thereof, our liability for the payment of such yearly sum or stipend, or of such part thereof, as the case may be, shall thereupon and thereafter cease and determine.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction consisting of a portion of the value of a certain piece or parcel of land comprising three acres three roods and twelve perches or thereabouts, which is about to be permanently secured as a site for a parsonage or house of residence for the vicarage of Shefford, in the county of Bedford, and in the diocese of Ely, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, sections five and eleven, grant and appropriate out of our common fund to the said vicarage of Shefford, to meet such benefaction, one capital sum of two hundred and fifty pounds, which we have agreed to pay as the consideration or part consideration for the conveyance in fee simple of the land above mentioned as and for a site for a parsonage or house of residence for the said vicarage of Shefford.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant out of the common fund under our control to the Incumbent for the time being of each of the several parishes and benefices in the county of Essex, and in the diocese of Saint Albans, which are named in the schedule hereto, a temporary yearly stipend of sixty pounds, such stipend to be payable for a period of four years, to be calculated as from the first day of November, in the year one thousand nine hundred and seven, and to be receivable in four equal portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and the first day of November in each of the said four years: Provided always, that the temporary yearly stipend of sixty pounds hereby granted to each of the Incumbents of the several benefices aforesaid shall be paid only upon the production to us on or after each of the said lastly-mentioned days of a certificate (in a form approved by us) under the hand of the Bishop of the diocese of Saint Albans, that during the
