other Sub-Districts of the same Registration District as follows, viz.:—(a) that Denham, Iver, and Langley Marish Civil Parishes should be added to Eton Sub-District, and (b) that Fulmer and Gerrard's Cross Civil Parishes should be added to Burnham Sub-District.

- 2. Now, therefore, I, Sir William Cospatrick Dunbar, Bart., C.B., Registrar-General of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers given me by the above mentioned Act, and with the sanction of the Local Government Board, do hereby order and declare that the foregoing alteration shall take effect accordingly.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and eight.
