Cape Frio—Breakers Reported Southward of.

Particulars.—With a considerable south-westerly swell prevailing, heavy breakers are reported to have been seen by the Master of the steamship Windhuk to the southward of Cape Frio.

Position.—About three miles from the coast and 8 miles S. 8° E. from False Cape Frio; lat. 18° 36' S., long. 12° 9' E.

Remarks.—A sounding of 20 fathoms was obtained abreast the breakers.

Variation.—22° W.
