URBAN DISTRICT OF OLDBURY.

NOTICE is hereby given, that it is the intention of the Urban District Council of Oldbury, in the county of Worcester (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), to transfer, by deed to be approved by the Board of Trade, the undertaking, and all their rights, powers, authorities, obligations, duties, and liabilities as Undertakers under the Oldbury Electric Lighting Order, 1898 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), to the Shropshire, Worcestershire, and Staffordshire Electric Power Company, incorporated under the Shropshire and Worcestershire Electric Power Act, 1903 (hereinafter called "the Company"), and that a copy of the draft deed of transfer is deposited for public inspection, during office hours, at the principal office of the Undertakers, Public-buildings, Freeth-street, Oldbury, within the area of supply, and that printed copies thereof will be supplied to every person demanding them at the price of sixpence for each copy.

Notice is also given that:—

(a) The area in respect of which the transfer is proposed to be made is the Urban District of Oldbury, as the same was constituted at the commencement of the Order.

(b) The period for which the transfer is proposed to be made is 42 years, computed from the 12th day of August, 1902, at the expiration of which period, or of any subsequent period of 7 years, the Council may, by notice in writing, require the Company to retransfer the Order, or until the Board of Trade may revoke the Order.

(c) The pecuniary consideration in respect of the transfer is the payment by the Company to the Council of the sum of £800, being the agreed costs, charges, payments, and expenses of the Council in obtaining the Order and its confirmation by Parliament, and the transfer thereof to the Company, including the costs of opposing all Bills which have been promoted by the Shropshire, Worcestershire, and Staffordshire Electric Power Company containing clauses affecting the Urban District of Oldbury.

(d) It is not proposed to except or modify any of the powers, duties, or liabilities of the Undertakers.

The terms upon which the transfer, is proposed to be made are:—

That in consideration of the Company paying to the Council the sum of £800, as set out in paragraph (c) of this Notice, the Council agree to transfer to the Company the undertaking, and all their rights, powers, authorities, obligations, duties, and liabilities, as Undertakers in respect thereof.
