MOTOR CAR ACT, 1903.

Regulations under Section 9 (1).

COUNTY OF SURREY.

Urban Districts of Barnes and East and West Molesey.

To the County Council of Surrey;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

Whereas by sub-section (1) of section 9 of the Motor Car Act, 1903 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), it is enacted that, within any limits or place referred to in Regulations made by Us, the Local Government Board, with a view to the safety of the public on the application of the Local Authority of the area in which the limits or place are situate, a person shall not drive a motor car at a speed exceeding ten miles per hour;

And whereas the County Council of Surrey, having made application to Us to make a Regulation in pursuance of the above-mentioned sub-section putting the provisions of that sub-section in force within the limits comprising certain roads situate within the urban districts of Barnes and East and West Molesey, in the county of Surrey, We directed a Local Inquiry to be held into the matter by one of Our Inspectors, and the Inquiry was held accordingly, and Report has been made to Us thereon:

Now therefore, in pursuance of the powers given to Us in that behalf, We do, by this Our Order, make the following Regulations:—

ARTICLE I.—The provisions of sub-section (1) of section 9 of the Act with respect to the driving of a motor car at a speed not exceeding ten miles per hour shall apply and have effect within the limits comprising the roads within the said urban districts which are specified in the Schedule hereto.

ARTICLE II.—These Regulations shall come into operation on the thirteenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and eight.

SCHEDULE.

Urban District of Barnes.

High-street, from its junction with Barnes-terrace to its junction with Church-road;

Church-road, from its junction with High-street to the Red Lion Public House, at Castlenau.

Urban District of East and West Molesey.

Bridge-road, East Molesey, extending from the county boundary on Hampton Court Bridge to the junction of the road with Walton-road.

ORDER of the Local Government Board: Motor Car Act, 1903: Regulations under Section 9 (1):—

COUNTY OF THE PARTS OF KESTEVEN.

PARISH OF COLSTERWORTH.

To the County Council of the Parts of Kesteven;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

Whereas by Sub-section (1) of Section 9 of the Motor Car Act, 1903 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), it is enacted that, within any limits or place referred to in regulations made by Us, the Local Government Board, with a view to the safety of the public on the application of the local authority of the area in which the limits or place are situate, a person shall not drive a motor car at a speed exceeding ten miles per hour;

And whereas the County Council of the Parts of Kesteven, having made application to Us to make a Regulation in pursuance of the above-mentioned Sub-section putting the provisions of that Sub-section in force within the limits comprising part of a certain road in the parish of Colsterworth, in the county of the Parts of Kesteven, We directed a Local Inquiry to be held into the matter by one of Our Inspectors, and the Inquiry was held accordingly, and Report has been made to Us thereon:

Now therefore, in pursuance of the powers given to Us in that behalf, We do, by this Our Order, make the following Regulations:—

ARTICLE I.—The provisions of Sub-section (1) of Section 9 of the Act with respect to the driving of a motor car at a speed not exceeding ten miles per hour shall apply and have effect within the limits comprising so much of the Great North Road, in the said parish, as extends from its junction with the northern end of Back Lane to the mile-stone indicating one hundred and two miles from London.

ARTICLE II.—These Regulations shall come into operation on the twentieth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and eight.
