The Board of Trade have received a copy of a Notice, dated March 27, issued by the Governor of Malta, amending the regulations respecting the importation of animals into that Island by the insertion of a clause, stating that all cattle shall be landed either at Ras Hanzir or elsewhere as the Chief Government Medical Officer, or the Government Veterinary Surgeon, may direct. Animals which, in the opinion of either of these Officers, may have been in contact with infected animals may be required to be landed at the Lazaretto, and there kept under observation.
