HONOURABLE ARTILLERY COMPANY.

(Appointment of Special Trustees in regard to certain lands and premises of the Honourable Artillery Company and other provisions in relation to such lands; Provisions as to civil rights and privileges now enjoyed or exercisable by the members of the Honourable Artillery Company; Amendment if necessary of the Territorial and Reserve Forces Act, 1907, and other purposes).

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament by the Honourable Artillery Company for leave to bring in a Bill during the present Session for the following purposes (that is to say):—

To appoint Special Trustees in regard to certain land and premises situate in the metropolitan borough of Finsbury in the administrative county of London, held under two leases, the one being dated the 30th day of December, 1858, and made between the Commissioners of Lieutenancy for the City of London of the one part, and the persons therein named as Trustees of the Honourable Artillery Company of the other part, and the other being dated the 23rd day of June, 1898, and made between the Mayor and Commonalty and Citizens of the City of London of the one part, and the persons therein named as Trustees of the Honourable Artillery Company of the other part, to the exclusion of the Territorial Force Association for the City of London or any other County Association constituted under the provisions of the Territorial and Reserve Forces Act, 1907.

To empower the Special Trustees so appointed to continue to hold the said land and premises in trust for the Honourable Artillery Company in all respects as the existing Trustees held the same before the Honourable Artillery Company became a unit of the Territorial Force, and to provide that the Honourable Artillery Company shall, notwithstanding any trust, limitation, or condition affecting the said land and premises, continue entitled to the benefit thereof in like manner as they were entitled thereto before they became a unit of the Territorial Force.

To provide for the continued enjoyment by the Honourable Artillery Company and the members thereof of their existing civil rights and privileges.

If and so far as may be necessary for the purpose of effecting the objects aforesaid to amend or vary the Territorial and Reserve Forces Act, 1907.

Notice is hereby further given, that in the event of leave being given by Parliament to deposit the said Bill, printed copies of the same will be forthwith deposited in the Private Bill Office of the House of Commons.

GREAT WESTERN RAILWAY.

(Alteration of Work.)

(Alteration in the parish of Wombourne, in the rural district of Seisdon, in the county of Stafford, of the Deviation Railway (No. 1) proposed to be authorized by the Bill.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that during the progress through the House of Lords, of the Bill introduced into Parliament in the present Session under the name or short title of the Great Western Railway, the following alteration has been made in the Deviation Railway (No. 1) proposed to be authorized by the Bill:—
