The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

The provisions of the Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1908 which require movement of swine in a float, cart or van shall not apply to movement along, over or across any street in the city of Glasgow.

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Extension of Limits of Swine-Fever Infected Area.

1. The limits of the Swine-Fever Infected Area declared by Order of the Board dated the thirtieth day of October, nineteen hundred and eight, are hereby extended so as to comprise the Area described in the Schedule to this Order, and the Area so described is hereby declared to be a Swine-Fever Infected Area for the purposes of the Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1908.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twelfth day of November, nineteen hundred and eight.

An Area in the administrative county of Norfolk comprising the petty sessional division of North Greenhoe and the parishes of North Barsham, West Barsham, East Barsham, Sculthorpe, Fakenham, Alothorpe, Little Snoring, Kettlestone, Pensthorpe, Little Ryburgh, Great Ryburgh, Testerton, Pudding Norton, Hempton, Toftrees, Shereford, and East Raynham.

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NOTICES TO MARINERS.

(Nos. 1724 to 1746 of the year 1908.)

[The Astronomical positions are only approximate unless seconds are given. The bearings are Magnetic, and those relating to lights are given from seaward. The visibility of lights is that in clear weather. Fog signals are sounded only during thick or foggy weather unless otherwise stated. The depths given are at low-water ordinary springs. The heights given are above high water.]

No. 1724.—ATLANTIC, CANARY ISLANDS—
LAS PALMAS BAY.

*La Luz Outer Harbour—Alterations in Buoyage ;
Caution.*

Subject.—The buoyage of La Luz Harbour has now been altered in accordance with the established system as follows:—

(a) Buoy established.

Position.—Situated at a distance of 565 yards, S. 43° W., from the green light at the end of the breakwater. Breakwater light (green). Lat. 28° 82' N., long. 15° 25' W.

Description.—Black buoy with black cylindrical topmark.

(b) Buoy removed.

Position.—Situated at a distance of 635 yards, S. 33° W., from the above light.

Description.—Red mooring buoy.

(c) Buoy moved and altered in colour. The red mooring buoy, situated at a distance of 475 yards, S. 71° W., from the above light, has been painted black and moved about 25 yards in a south-easterly direction to the following position.

Position.—Situated at a distance of 475 yards, S. 68° W., from the Breakwater Lighthouse.

Description.—Black mooring buoy.

(d) Buoy altered in colour. The red mooring buoy, situated at a distance of 480 yards, N. 82° W., from the above light is now painted black.

(e) Buoy moved and altered in colour. The red mooring buoy, situated at a distance of 580 yards, N. 57° W., from the above light, has been painted white and moved about 45 yards in a west-north-westerly direction to the following position.

Position.—Situated at a distance of 620 yards, N. 57° W., from the above light.

Description.—White spherical mooring buoy.

Remarks.—Mooring buoys painted white are used for mooring purposes exclusively.
