

ORDER of the Local Government Board: Making certain Orders applicable to new Union:—

SOUTHAMPTON UNION.

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Southampton Union;—

To the Overseers of the Poor of the several Parishes comprised in the said Union;—
And to all others whom it may concern.

Whereas by an Order, dated the 24th day of January, 1908, We, the Local Government Board, ordered that, from and after the 25th day of March, 1908, the parishes of All Saints, Holy Rhood, Portswood, Saint John, Saint Lawrence, Saint Mary, Saint Michael, and Shirley, in the county borough of Southampton, should be united for the administration of the laws for the relief of the Poor, and form a Union to be termed the Southampton Union;

And whereas it is expedient that the provisions of the General Orders addressed to the Guardians of the Poor of such of the several Unions in England and Wales as have been formed under the Acts relating to the relief of the Poor, and in force in those Unions, and of certain General Orders which are specified in the schedule to this Order, issued from time to time by the Poor Law Commissioners, the Poor Law Board, and by Us, should be made applicable to and be in force in the said Southampton Union:

Now We, the Local Government Board, hereby Order as follows:—

From and after the twenty-fifth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and eight, the provisions of the above-mentioned General Orders shall, subject to the provisions of the Local Government Act, 1894, apply to and be in force in the Southampton Union.
