

among the wards so determined, that is to say:—

COUNTY BOROUGH OF SOUTHAMPTON.

The boundaries of the wards of the said borough of Southampton to be as follows, namely:—

No. 1 Town Ward.

Commencing at a point in the centre of Above Bar-street opposite the centre of Bargate-street, thence proceeding in a southerly direction through the Bargate and along the centre of High-street to its junction with East-street, thence eastwards along the centre of East-street and Marsh-lane to Terminus-terrace, thence southwards along the centre of Terminus-terrace to its junction with the Platform-road, thence westwards along the centre of the Platform-road to its junction with Orchard-place, thence southwards in a straight line to the most westerly angle of the Docks, thence continuing in the same direction to the boundary of the borough in the River Test, thence in a north-westerly direction following the boundary of the borough to a point bearing due south of the intersection of Sidford-street and Southbrook-road, thence due north in the direction of the last-mentioned point of intersection to a point due west of the point of intersection of Bargate-street and Western Esplanade, thence eastwards in a straight line to the last-mentioned point of intersection, and continuing thence in the same direction along the centre of Bargate-street to the point of commencement aforesaid.

No. 2 Saint Mary's Ward.

Commencing at a point in the northern boundary of No. 1 Town Ward hereinbefore defined in the centre of East-street opposite the centre of Strand, and proceeding thence in a northerly direction along the centres of Strand and of Palmerston-road to South Front, thence easterly along the centres of South Front, Bevois-street, and Longcroft-street, thence continuing in an easterly direction along a line in prolongation of the centre of Longcroft-street to the boundary of the borough in the centre of the River Itchen, thence following the boundary of the borough in a southerly and north-westerly direction to the boundary of No. 1 Town Ward, and thence following the boundary of No. 1 Town Ward in northerly, easterly, northerly, and westerly directions successively to the point of commencement aforesaid.

No. 3 Northam Ward.

Commencing at the point of intersection of the centre of the main line rails of the London and South Western Railway with the northern boundary of No. 2 Saint Mary's Ward hereinbefore defined, and proceeding thence northwards along the centre of the said main line to Northam Railway Bridge, thence in a south-westerly direction along the centre of Northam-road to Derby-road, thence northward along the centre of Derby-road to Mount Pleasant-road, thence eastwards along the centre of Mount Pleasant-road to the centre of the main line of the London and South Western Railway, thence northward along the centre of the said main line of railway to the bridge over the same connecting Dukes-road and Priory-road, thence south-easterly in a straight line (in the direction of the tower adjacent to Bitterne Manor House) to the boundary of the borough in the centre of the River Itchen, thence in a southerly direction following the boundary of the borough to No. 2 Saint Mary's Ward opposite Longcroft-street, thence in a westerly direction following the northern boundary of No. 2 Saint

Mary's Ward to the point of commencement aforesaid.

No. 4 Trinity Ward.

Commencing at a point in the northern boundary of No. 2 Saint Mary's Ward at the intersection of South Front and Palmerston-road, and proceeding thence in a northerly direction along the centres of Palmerston-road and East Park-terrace to Compton-walk, thence eastwards along the centre of Compton-walk across Saint Mary's-road and along the centre of Oxford-avenue to the boundary of No. 3 Northam Ward hereinbefore defined, thence southwards, eastwards, and southwards successively following the boundary of No. 3 Northam Ward aforesaid to the northern boundary of No. 2 Saint Mary's Ward aforesaid, thence westwards following the said northern boundary to the point of commencement aforesaid.

No. 5 Newtown Ward.

Commencing at the north-western angle of No. 4 Trinity Ward hereinbefore defined at the intersection of Compton-walk and East Park-terrace, and proceeding thence in a northerly direction along the centre of East Park-terrace and westwards along the centre of Brunswick-place to London-road, thence northwards along the centres of London-road and the Avenue to a point opposite the centre of Middle-street, thence eastwards along the centre of Middle-street to Peterborough-road, thence southwards along the centre of Peterborough-road to Bevois Valley, thence north-eastwards along the centre of Bevois Valley to Mount Pleasant-road, thence in an easterly direction along the centre of Mount Pleasant-road to the western boundary of No. 3 Northam Ward aforesaid, thence southwards following the said western boundary and westwards following the northern boundary of No. 4 Trinity Ward aforesaid to the point of commencement aforesaid.

No. 6 All Saints Ward.

Commencing at a point on the western boundary of No. 5 Newtown Ward, hereinbefore defined, at the intersection of the Avenue and Rockstone-place, and proceeding thence westwards along the centre of Rockstone-place to Carlton-crescent, thence continuing in the same direction along the centre of Carlton-crescent to Carlton-road, thence in a northerly direction along the centre of Carlton-road to Milton-road, thence westwards along the centre of Milton-road to Hill-lane, thence southwards along the centre of Hill-lane and Sidford-street to the intersection of Sidford-street and Southbrook-road, thence in a straight line to the north-west angle of No. 1 Town Ward hereinbefore defined, thence following the northern boundary of No. 1 Town Ward to Strand and the western boundaries of No. 2 Saint Mary's Ward and of No. 4 Trinity Ward to Compton-walk and the southern boundary of No. 5 Newtown Ward, westwards to the London-road and the western boundary of the said No. 5 Newtown Ward to the point of commencement aforesaid.

No. 7 Bevois Ward.

Commencing at the north-western angle of No. 5 Newtown Ward in the centre of the Avenue opposite the centre of Middle-street, and proceeding thence northwards along the centre of the Avenue to Winn-road, thence in a north-easterly direction along the centre of Winn-road to Brook Vale-road and thence south-eastwards along the centre of Brook Vale-road to Portswood-road, and thence southwards along the
