TEMPORARY ORDER: Relief to Able-bodied Men, their Wives and Families.

NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE UNION.

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Newcastle upon Tyne Union;

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by a General Order dated the 14th day of December, 1852, addressed to the Guardians of the Poor of certain Unions and Parishes, including the Newcastle upon Tyne Union, the Poor Law Board prescribed Regulations with regard to the administration of out-door relief to poor persons in the said Union;

And whereas it is expedient that further provision should be made temporarily with regard to the administration of relief to certain classes of poor persons in the said Union:

NOW THEREFORE, we, the Local Government Board, in pursuance of the powers given to us by the Statutes in that behalf, hereby order as follows:—

ARTICLE 1.—The Guardians of the Poor of the Newcastle upon Tyne Union may, after not less than seven days' notice of the proposal has been sent by their Clerk to each Guardian, pass a Resolution (hereinafter referred to as "the Resolution") to the effect that the powers conferred by this Order shall be exercised by them, and a copy of the Resolution
