

Honorary Canon of the Cathedral Church of Liverpool, rector or incumbent of the rectory of the parish of Wigan in the said county and diocese, and, as such rector or incumbent, the patron of the vicarage of the said new parish of Pemberton, and with the consent of James Carlton Eckersley, of Carlton Manor, Yeadon, Leeds, esquire, as the patron of the vicarage of the said new parish of Saint James, Wigan (in testimony whereof they the said consenting parties have respectively signed and sealed this representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, humbly represent, that it would, in our opinion, be expedient that all those contiguous portions of the said new parish of Pemberton and of the said new parish of Saint James, Wigan, which are described in the schedule hereunder written, all which portions, together with the boundaries thereof, are delineated and set forth on the map or plan hereunto annexed, should be united and formed into one consolidated chapelry for the said church of Saint Matthew, Highfield, situate as aforesaid, and that the same should be named 'The Consolidated Chapelry of Saint Matthew, Highfield.'

"We, therefore, humbly pray that Your Majesty will be graciously pleased to take the premises into Your Royal consideration, and to make such Order in respect thereto as to Your Majesty in Your Royal Wisdom shall seem meet.

"The SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Representation has reference.

"The consolidated chapelry of Saint Matthew, Highfield, comprising:—

"I. All that portion of the new parish (sometime district chapelry) of Pemberton, in the county of Lancaster and in the diocese of Liverpool, which is bounded upon part of the north and upon the north-east by the new parish of Saint Mark, Newtown, Pemberton, upon the east by the new parish (sometime district) of Saint James, Wigan, upon the south by the parish of Ashton in Makerfield, upon the west partly by the new parish of Billinge and partly by the new parish of Upholland, all in the said county and diocese, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the north-west and upon the remaining part of the north, by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundary which divides the said new parish of Upholland from the said new parish of Pemberton crosses the middle of the Liverpool, Bolton, and Bury line of the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway, and extending thence eastward along the middle of the said line of railway for a distance of fifteen chains or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge which carries the footpath leading from Highfield into Smethurst-lane across the said line of railway, and extending thence north-westward along the middle of the said footpath for a distance of eleven chains or thereabouts to its junction with Smethurst-lane, and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of Smethurst-lane and of Sandon-street (which runs in continuation thereof) for a distance in all of twenty-five chains or thereabouts to the junction of Sandon-street with Ormskirk-road, and extending thence eastward along the middle of Ormskirk-road for a distance of thirteen chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said new parish of Pemberton from the said new parish of Saint Mark, Newtown, Pemberton.

"II. And also all that contiguous portion of the said new parish of Saint James, Wigan, which is bounded upon the south-east by the said parish of Ashton in Makerfield, upon the west partly by the above-described portion of the said new parish of Pemberton, and partly by the said new parish of Saint Mark, Newtown, Pemberton, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the north and upon the north-east, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said new parish of Saint Mark, Newtown, Pemberton, from the said new parish of Saint James, Wigan, at the centre of the bridge which carries the Pemberton loop line of the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway across Warrington-road and extending thence south-eastward along the middle of such line of railway for a distance of ten chains and a half or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge which carries it across the line of the Winstanley Colliery Railway, and extending thence southward along the middle of the last-mentioned line of railway for a distance of thirteen chains or thereabouts to the point where it crosses the middle of the road called Shelley-drive, and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of Shelley-drive for a distance of twelve yards or thereabouts to its junction with the footpath known as Carr's-lane, and extending thence south-eastward along the middle of Carr's-lane (thereby crossing Poolstock-lane and Hawkley Brook) for a distance of sixty-six chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said new parish of Saint James, Wigan, from the said parish of Ashton in Makerfield."

And whereas the said representation has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said representation, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts. And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said diocese of Liverpool.
