

WHARF ROAD, King's Cross.	Twenty Carriages. At East side of Wharf Road, King's Cross, commencing at junction of Battle Bridge Road; front of vehicles toward the South.
MACFARLANE PLACE and SHEPHERD'S BUSH.	One Hundred and Four Carriages. First portion.—Four carriages on the South Side of Macfarlane Place, near the entrance to the Exhibition; front of vehicles toward the East. Second portion:—One hundred carriages, commencing on the West side of Shepherd's Bush Green, at junction of Uxbridge Road, extending Southwards along the same and continuing along South side of Shepherd's Bush Green as far as necessary; front of vehicles toward the North. Cabs joining the Standing must proceed by way of Addison Gardens, Sinclair Gardens, Winford Gardens, and Rockley Road, except those setting down at the main entrance in Uxbridge Road, which may join the Standing at the East corner of Shepherd's Bush Green.
LOWER RICHMOND ROAD and PUTNEY.	Five Carriages. At North side of Lower Richmond Road, Putney, beside kerb:— To commence by first lamp-post East of roadway to Draw Dock, and extending Eastward as far as necessary; front of vehicles toward the West.
PRIORY GROVE, Kensington.	Two Carriages. First portion:—One carriage in the centre of the carriageway at Drayton Gardens, on the South side of Priory Grove; front of vehicle toward the North. Second portion:—One carriage on the South side of Priory Grove, Kensington, on the West side of Drayton Gardens; front of vehicle toward the East. The first portion to be fed by the carriage from the second portion.
LADY MARGARET ROAD, Southall.	Two Carriages. At Lady Margaret Road, Southall, commencing ten yards from its junction with High Street; front of vehicles toward the South.
WINDMILL HILL, Enfield.	Two Vehicles. At South side of Windmill Hill, Enfield, outside the Great Northern Railway Station; front of vehicles toward the East.
EBENEZER TERRACE, Enfield.	Two Vehicles. At East side of Ebenezer Terrace, Enfield, by wall of Great Eastern Railway Station; front of vehicles toward the North.
EPSOM DOWNS RAILWAY STATION.	Two Vehicles. In Longdown Road, Epsom Downs, by the kerb on West side, near North-east entrance to Epsom Downs Railway Station; front of vehicles facing North-east. N.B.—This Standing will not be available on days when there is racing at Epsom.
FOXLEY HATCH, God- stone Road, Purley.	Six Vehicles. At Foxley Hatch, Godstone Road, Purley, one yard West of public street lamp (South side), extending as far as necessary; front of carriages facing Brighton Road.
DORSET STREET, W.	Four Vehicles. In centre of Dorset Street, commencing East of Montague Mansions, and extending as far as necessary; front of vehicles facing West.
BEAUFORT STREET, Chelsea.	One Vehicle. In centre of roadway opposite No. 113, Beaufort Mansions, Beaufort Street, Chelsea; front of vehicle toward the North.
PORTLAND PLACE, New Cavendish Street.	Sixteen Vehicles. In two portions:— First portion:—Eight carriages in centre of Portland Place, commencing opposite No. 19, and extending Northwards as far as necessary; front of vehicles facing South. Second portion:—Eight carriages to stand in rear of refuge in centre of Portland Place, North of New Cavendish Street, extending as far as necessary; front of vehicles facing South. The first portion to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.
