WADDON NEW ROAD, Croydon. Ten Vehicles.

In two portions, viz.:-

First portion:—One carriage on North side of Waddon New Road, Croydon, 19 feet from the crossing in Waddon New Road; horse's head Eastward.

Second portion:—Nine carriages on North side of Waddon New Road, commencing 100 feet in rear of first carriage, and extending Westward as far as necessary; horses' heads Eastward.

The first portion to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.

VILLIERS STREET.

Twenty Vehicles.

In two portions:-First portion:—Eleven carriages, commencing outside Northwestern door of Charing Cross District Railway Station, and extending Westward along the kerb along South side of Villiers Street to Northumberland Avenue; horses' heads Eastwards.

Second portion: -Nine carriages, commencing on North side of Villiers Street outside No. 5, The Facade, and extending Eastward next the kerb to West side of No. 1, The Facade; horses' heads Westward.

HAMPTON COURT GREEN, Vrow Walk. Three Vehicles.

At Hampton Court Green, on the West side of the road by the Vrow Walk:

Commencing 100 yards from the North-east corner of Hampton Court Green, and extending in a Southerly direction as far as necessary; horses' heads Northward.

BRONDESBURY RAILWAY STATION:

Six Vehicles.

At Brondesbury Railway Station, to commence on the North side of the entrance to the station in the Edgware Road, and extend along the kerb under the Railway Company's wall as far as necessary; horses' heads facing North.

ST. GEORGE'S ROAD, St. George's Bridge. Three Vehicles.

At St. George's Road, Pimlico, centre of St. George's Bridge, West side; horses' heads Northward.

CARDINGTON STREET, Hampstead Road. Ten Vehicles.

On the North side of Cardington Street, St. Pancras, commencing at the junction of Hampstead Road, and extending Eastward close to the kerb as far as necessary, keeping clear of the London and North Western Railway Gates; horses' heads Westward.

HORNSEY ROAD, Seven Sisters Road. Six Vehicles.

On the East side of Hornsey Road, Holloway, commencing nine feet from the crossing in Seven Sisters Road, and extending Northwards along the kerb as far as necessary; horses' heads towards Seven Sisters Road.

VERE STREET, Oxford Street. Two Vehicles.

In the centre of Vere Street, North of refuge by Oxford Street, extending Northwards as far as necessary; horses' heads to the

VERE STREET, Henrietta Street. Two Vehicles.

In the centre of Vere Street, South of refuge by Henrietta Street, extending Southwards as far as necessary; horses' heads to the North.

GLOUCESTER PLACE, Bickenhall Mansions. Three Vehicles.

At the corner of Gloucester Place, South side of dead wall by Bickenhall Mansions; horses' heads facing Gloucester Place.

PORTLAND PLACE, New Cavendish Street.

Eight Vehicles.

In the centre of Portland Place, commencing at New Cavendish Street, and extending Southwards towards Duchess Street as far as necessary; horses' heads to the North.

Vauxhall Walk, Albert Embankment.

Four Vehicles.

On the North side of Vauxhall Walk, Albert Embankment, one carriage to stand West to the entrance to Goffs Stables, the three remaining East of same; horses' heads Westward.
