Pursuant to the directions contained in the twenty-sixth section of the first-mentioned Act of Parliament, I, the said Bishop, have drawn up a scheme in writing annexed to this Representation describing the several districts so as aforesaid proposed to be annexed to the respective parishes of Lexden, St. Mary the Virgin, Colchester, Holy Trinity, Col-chester, St. Giles, Colchester, St. Botolph, Colchester, St. Mary Magdalen, Colchester, St. Peter, Colchester, St. Paul, Colchester, St. James, Colchester, and Greenstead, and the mode in which it appears to me that the alterations may best be effected and how the changes consequent thereon in respect to Ecclesiastical jurisdiction, glebe lands, tithes, rent charges, and other Ecclesiastical dues, rates and payments, and in respect of patronage and rights to pews may be made with justice to all parties interested, and I do hereby submit the same to Your Grace, together with the consents in writing, of the persons whose names are set out in the second column of the Schedule to the last paragraph above written, being the patrons of the said several benefices mentioned in the first column of the said Schedule and set against their names respectively, and of the said persons whose names are set out in the third column of the said Schedule, being the incumbents of the benefices respectively against their names in the first column of the said Schedule, and in case you shall, on full consideration and inquiry, be satisfied therewith, I request that Your Grace will be pleased to certify the same and the consents aforesaid by your Report to His Majesty in Council.

- "1. It is proposed to separate the following districts from the parishes of Holy Trinity, St. James, and St. Mary the Virgin, Colchester, and to annex the same for Ecclesiastical purposes to the adjoining parish of Lexden, namely:—
- "(1) A district being a detached portion of the said parish of Holy Trinity, Colchester, which is delineated and described in the plan No. 1 annexed hereto, and thereon numbered 1 and coloured light red, and situate on the eastern boundary of the said parish of Lexden, and separated therefrom by the district next hereinafter mentioned.
- "(2) A district being a detached portion of the said parish of St. James, Colchester, which is delineated and described in the plan No. 1 annexed hereto, and thereon numbered 2 and coloured light purple, and adjoining the lastmentioned district.
- "(3) A district of the said parish of St. Mary the Virgin, Colchester, which is delineated and described in the plan No. 1
