

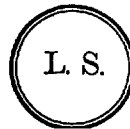
ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

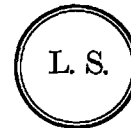

(2) The premises known as Hammond's Farm, in the parish of Udimore, in the administrative county of East Sussex, in the occupation of J. G. Mair, of Rumley.
