THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907.

MUNICIPAL BOROUGH OF BANGOR.

NOTICE.

THE Local Government Board having, by an Order dated the 5th day of August, 1911, declared certain parts and sections of the above Act to be in force within the above named Borough. Notice is hereby given that the effect of the said Order is, subject to the conditions and adaptations hereinafter mentioned, shortly as follows:—

ARTICLE I.—(1.) On and after the day on which the Order comes into operation sections 15 to 24 (inclusive) and sections 26 to 33 (inclusive), comprised in Part II; sections 34 to 50 (inclusive), comprised in Part III; Part IV; Part V; and Part X of the said Act shall be in force in the District.

(2.) Certain conditions and adaptations of the above, mentioned in the Schedule, are to apply until further order.

ARTICLE II contains directions as to advertising the Order.

ARTICLE III.—The Order to come into operation on the 18th September, 1911.

EPITOME OF THE SCHEDULE.

PART II.

Section Twenty-seven. (7) Not to apply to Territorial Force.

Section Thirty. Not to apply to wall supporting street or footpath by reason of surface of the street or footpath being above or below level of the surface of adjoining land (except in certain events).

PART III.

Section Thirty-five. Exception in favour of a person who has not rejected offer of Local Authority to bear one-half expense of construction of cistern. As to deposit of material this section to be subject to the first proviso of section 91 P.H.A., 1875.

Power as to bye-laws under section 23 of M.C.A., 1882, for suppression of nuisances not to be exercisable in relation to this section.

Section Thirty-eight. Order not to affect power of owner or occupier by virtue of section 22 P.H.A., 1875, or section 18 of P.H.A. Amendment Act, 1890.

PART IV.

Section Fifty-nine. Not to apply to a library not within the district.

PART V.

Section Seventy-five. The date of the Order for this part to be the beginning of the period for which the Local Authority shall give notice under sub-section (1) of this section.
