MOTOR CAR ACT, 1903.

Regulations under Section 9 (1).

COUNTY OF SURREY.

Parish of Mickleham.

To the County Council of Surrey;—
And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by sub-section (1) of section 9 of the Motor Car Act, 1903 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), it is enacted that, within any limits or place referred to in Regulations made by Us, the Local Government Board, with a view to the safety of the public on the application of the local authority of the area in which the limits or place are situate, a person shall not drive a motor car at a speed exceeding ten miles per hour;

And whereas We have received and duly considered an application from the County Council of Surrey for the issue of a Regulation in pursuance of the said sub-section putting the above-mentioned provisions of that subsection in force within the limits comprising part of a certain road situate within the Parish of Mickleham, in the County of Surrey:

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of the powers given to Us in that behalf, We do, by this Our Order, make the following Regulations:—

ARTICLE I.—The provisions of sub-section (1) of section 9 of the Act with respect to the driving of a motor car at a speed not exceeding ten miles per hour shall apply and have effect within the limits comprising the road through the village of Mickleham from a point situate 100 yards to the east of Mickleham Corner to a point opposite the Lodge Gates of Mickleham Hall.

ARTICLE II.—These Regulations shall come into operation on the twenty-third day of October, one thousand nine hundred and eleven.
