MOTOR CAR ACT, 1903. Regulations under Section 9 (1).

BOROUGH OF CHATHAM.

To the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the Borough of Chatham ;-

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by sub-section (1) of section 9 of the Motor Car Act, 1903 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), it is enacted that, within any limits or place referred to in regulations made by Us, the Local Government Board, with a view to the safety of the public, on the application of the local authority of the area in which the limits or place are situate, a person shall not drive a motor car at a speed exceeding ten miles per hour;

And whereas the Town Council of the borough of Chatham, having made application to Us to make a Regulation in pursuance of the said sub-section putting the above men-tioned provisions of that sub-section in force within the limits comprising certain roads or parts of roads within the borough of Chatham, We directed a Local Inquiry to be held into the matter by one of Our Inspectors, and the Inquiry was held accordingly, and report has been made to Us thereon :

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of the powers given to Us in that behalf, We do, by this Our Order, make the following Regulations :

ARTICLE I.-The provisions of sub-section (1) of section 9 of the Act with respect to the driving of a motor car at a speed not exceeding ten miles per hour shall apply and have effect within the limits comprising so much of High Street, Chatham, as extends from its junction with the road known as "Brook" to the western boundary of the borough.

ARTICLE II.—These Regulations shall come into operation on the thirtieth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and eleven.

Given under the Seal of Office of the Local Government Board, this seventeenth day of October, in the year one thousand nine hundred and eleven.
