The KING has been pleased to give and grant unto Dudley Melchior Beaumont von Gurowski, of Wield Manor, in the county of Southampton, Esquire, only son of Melchior Bolivar von Gurowski, Count Gurowski, deceased, who was only son of Etienne Adam von Gurowski, Count Gurowski, eldest son of Wladislaus von Gurowski, Count Gurowski, who was eldest son to leave issue of Raphael Christoph von Gurowski, Count Gurowski, all deceased, His Royal Licence and authority that he and the heirs male of his body in succession (being respectively subjects of His Majesty's Realms), upon whom the title of Count shall descend, may bear and use the title of Count in this country, in the manner declared in the Diploma granted by His Majesty Frederick William, King of Prussia, to the said Raphael Christoph von Gurowski, and bearing date the fifth day of November, one thousand seven hundred and eighty-seven.

And to command that the said Royal Concession and especial mark of Royal favour, together with the said Diploma, be registered in His Majesty's College of Arms.
