takings and with Local Authorities or Others -Incorporation and Amendment of Acts.)

OTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made in Parliament in the ensuing session by Francis Henry Young of Stillyans Horeham-road in the county of Sussex for an Act for all or any of the following purposes (that is to say):

1. To incorporate a Company with all the usual and necessary powers and to confer upon the Company so incorporated (in this Notice referred to as "the Company") power to

supply water.

2. To define the capital and other powers of the Company and to make provision for the administration and the carrying on of its business

3. To empower the Company to sink a well or wells and to construct all necessary works in connection therewith near the present well of the Ticehurst and District Water and Gas Company in the parish of Ticehurst in the

county of Sussex.

- 4. To authorize the purchase by the Company by agreement or otherwise of the undertaking works main pipes lands water sources of water agreements rights privileges and powers belonging to the Ticehurst and District Water and Gas Company (so far as the same relate to the water part of the said Water and Gas Undertaking) and to confer upon the said Water and Gas Company all necessary powers for the carrying of such sale and purchase into effect.
- 5. To provide for the transfer to and vesting in the Company of the said Water Undertaking works rights powers and properties (or any part or parts thereof) to provide for the application of the purchase money or moneys and to provide for any necessary or consequential alteration amendment or repeal of the rights powers privileges or obligations of the said Water and Gas Company and to confirm and authorize the carrying into effect of any agreement or agreements between the Company and the said Water and Gas Company entered into prior to the passing of the intended Act for the sale and purchase of the said undertaking works rights powers and properties or any part thereof or otherwise.
- 6. To authorize the Company to enter into and carry into effect contracts and arrangements with the Heathfield and District Water Company Limited for the acquisition and purchase by the Company of the Waterworks mains pipes lands water sources of water agreements rights privileges or powers lately belonging to the East Sussex Gas Light Coke and Water Company Limited.

7. To alter repeal or amend the Ticehurst Water Act, 1902, and the Ticehurst and District Water Act, 1904.

- 8. To incorporate with or without variation all or some of the provisions of the Companies Clauses Acts, the Waterworks Clauses Acts, 1847 and 1863 and any other General Statutes.
- 9. To empower the Company to carry on the undertaking of the said Water and Gas Companies or so much thereof as they may acquire as an amalgamated water undertaking and to complete maintain enlarge improve renew or discontinue the works of such undertakings (or any parts thereof) and to authorize the Company to supply water for public domestic trade and all other purposes to and within an area

comprising the existing authorized areas of the said Water and Gas Companies (or either of them) including the parishes of Burwash Etchingham Salehurst and Ticehurst in the rural district of Ticehurst and the parish of Heathfield in the rural district of Hailsham and within an extended area comprising the parish of Waldron in the rural district of Uckfield and so much of the parish of Hellingly in the rural district of Hailsham as shall be described in the Bill all in the county of Sussex.

10. To authorize the Company to construct and maintain in connection with the works to be acquired by them any necessary or convenient subsidiary works (including telegraphs and telephones) and for the purposes thereof to stop up and divert or alter roads and footpaths and to empower the Company to erect dwellings for persons in their employment upon land belong-

ing to them.

11. To authorize the Company to discharge water from any of their waterworks into any

available stream watercourse or pond.

12. To empower the Company subject to the provisions of the Bill to take divert impound collect store and use the water which may or can be intercepted or taken by means of the waterworks and subsidiary works to be acquired or authorized.

13. To empower the Company for the purposes of or in connection with their undertaking (including the protection of their Water Supply against pollution) to purchase or take on lease lands and easements by agreement and hold the same and any water or other rights connected

therewith.

14. To empower the Company to make and recover rates and charges for the supply of water throughout their proposed limits of supply; to empower the Company to make and recover rates, rents and charges for the supply of water by measure and for the supply use or hire of meters fittings apparatus and things; to alter all or any of the existing rates rents and charges and to confirm vary or extinguish exemptions from payments of rates rents

and charges.

To make provision in regard to the supply of water and amongst other things with reference to the following matters: The dates for the payment of water rates; the payment of rates by owners of small houses; the provision of separate communication pipes for each house; notice of discontinuance; the prevention and detection of waste undue consumption misuse and contamination of water; the fixing of meters and other instruments for the detection and prevention of waste; the maintenance and repair of communication pipes; the supply of water by measure; the exemption of obligation to supply except by measure premises used partly for trade and other purposes; the definition and limitation of domestic purposes for which water may be used except when supplied by measure; the use of hose pipes; the pressure at which water is to be supplied; the sale and letting by the Company of meters pipes and fittings and the extension thereto of section 14 of the Waterworks Clauses Act, 1863, regulations as to supply by meter; the making of bye-laws; the imposition and recovery of penalties in respect of all or any such matters.
