

MOTOR CAR ACT, 1903.

COUNTY OF LONDON.

Whereas by sub-section (1) of section 9 of the Motor Car Act, 1903, it is enacted that within any limits or place referred to in regulations made by the Local Government Board with a view to the safety of the public, on the application of the local authority of the area in which the limits or place are situate, a person shall not drive a motor car at a speed exceeding ten miles per hour;

Notice is hereby given, that the London County Council have made application to the Local Government Board for a regulation to be made in pursuance of the said sub-section putting the above-mentioned provisions of that sub-section in force within the limits comprising High Street, Deptford;

Notice is hereby further given, that objections to the making of any such regulation may be sent in writing to the Local Government Board at their offices in Whitehall, London, on or before the 28th day of April, 1913.

A copy of any such objection should be sent at the same time by the objector to the County Council, addressed to the Clerk to the London County Council, County Hall, Spring Gardens, S.W.

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 4TH APRIL 1913.)

SHEEP-SCAB (NORTH CARDIGAN-
SHIRE) ORDER OF 1913.

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1911, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Application of Order.

1.—(1.) This Order shall apply to any premises in that portion of the administrative county of Cardigan subject to the Sheep-Scab (North Cardiganshire and Machynlleth District) Order of 1910 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") to which it may be applied by a Notice to that effect signed by an Inspector of the Local Authority and served upon the occupier of the premises described in such Notice.

(2.) This Order shall cease to apply to any premises to which it may be applied upon service on the occupier thereof of a Notice to that effect signed by an Inspector of the Board.

(3.) A copy of every Notice served under this Article shall forthwith be sent to the Board by the Inspector signing the same.

Compulsory Dipping in July on Premises to which this Order is applied.

2.—(1.) In addition to the compulsory dipping required by Part II of the principal Order, the owner of any sheep on any premises to which this Order may be applied, between the thirtieth day of June and the first day of August in each year shall cause the same to be dipped between those dates by a thorough immersion in a sheep dip approved by the Board for sheep-scab or purporting to be so approved. This provision shall not apply to sheep moved from such premises under and in accordance with Article 3 of this Order, or slaughtered on such premises between the thirtieth day of June and the first day of August.

(2.) The dipping shall be carried out on such date, at such dipping place, and in such manner as shall be required by a notice signed by an Inspector of the Local Authority of the district, and served by post, or otherwise, on the owner or person in charge of the sheep referred to in the notice.

Restriction on Movement from Premises to which this Order is applied.

3. Between the thirtieth day of June and the first day of August sheep shall not be moved from any premises to which this Order may be applied, whether to premises in the Dipping Area to which the principal Order applies or elsewhere, except under the same restrictions as under the principal Order are imposed on movement of sheep out of the Dipping Area.

Local Authority to enforce Order.

4. The provisions of this Order shall be executed and enforced by the Local Authority.
