Section 81 (Part of).

HALE URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL.

Extension of Definition of Street for Certain  
Purposes.

NOTICE is hereby given, that by virtue of an Order of one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, dated the 17th day of July, 1913, it was declared that the following part of section 81 (extending definition of public place and street for certain purposes) of Part VII of the said Act be in force in the Urban District of Hale:—

"Any unfenced ground adjoining or abutting upon any street in an urban district shall

be deemed to be a street for the purpose of so much of section 28 of the Town Police Clauses Act, 1847, as relates to the following offences:—

"Every person who throws or lays any dirt, litter, ashes, or night soil or any carrion, fish, offal or rubbish on any street."

## THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907.

BILSTON URBAN DISTRICT.

NOTICE is hereby given, that by an Order dated the 7th day of July, 1913, the Local Government Board have confirmed an Order made on the thirtieth day of November, 1912, by the Urban District Council of Bilston, in pursuance of section 112 of the Public Health Act, 1875, as amended by section 51 of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, declaring each of the trades of Fish frier, Manufacturer of Manure from Fish, Fish offal, Blood, or other putrescible animal matter, Dealer in Rags and Bones, Leather dresser, Glue maker, Size maker, Fat melter or Fat extractor, Blood drier, Gut scraper, Fat dealer and Hide and Skin dealer within the urban district to be an offensive trade.
