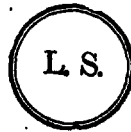
FISHGUARD IRISH ANIMALS LANDING PLACE ORDER OF 1913 (No. 3).

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1911, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do hereby revoke the Order described in the Schedule hereto, and do hereby define the following part of the Port of Fishguard as a landing place for Irish animals; that is to say:

All that space situate at Fishguard, in the administrative county of Pembroke, in the occupation of the Great Western Railway Company, which is coloured pink and vermilion on the plan sealed by the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries for the purposes of this Order, and deposited at the office of the Board.

This Order may be cited as the FISHGUARD IRISH ANIMALS LANDING PLACE ORDER OF 1913 (No. 3).
