The Board of Trade have received, through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, a copy of a Despatch, dated the 13th November, from His Majesty's Consul-General at San Francisco, stating that the following measures have been put in force at that port, owing to the discovery of plague-infected rats at Seattle:—

Vessels arriving from Seattle are inspected by quarantine officers on entering the port before going alongside wharves. After unloading, if the quarantine officer deems it desirable, the vessel must be thoroughly fumigated before loading. The fumigation, however, can be carried out at Seattle, in which case the Master of the vessel is provided with a certificate by the authorities at that port to the effect that fumigation has been properly effected there. All vessels have to use rat guards on all ropes leading from ship to wharf.
