

the parishes or cures of Edgware; Great Stanmore; Harrow-on-the-Hill; Saint James, Alperton; Saint John the Baptist, Greenhill; All Saints, Harrow Weald; Christ Church, Roxeth; Holy Trinity, Wealdstone; Saint John, Wembley; Kingsbury; Little Stanmore; Northwood; Emmanuel, Northwood; Pinner; Saint Anselm, Hatch End; and Saint George, Headstone; all at present in the Rural Deanery of Willesden and in the Archdeaconry of Hampstead, and the parish or cure of Northolt, at present in the Rural Deanery of Ealing, and in the Archdeaconry of Middlesex, and secondly that as from the same date the Rural Deanery of Holborn, at present in the Archdeaconry of Hampstead, shall be transferred to the Archdeaconry of London, and that each of the parishes or cures or churches comprised in the said new Rural Deanery of Harrow shall be subject to the jurisdiction and authority of the Rural Dean of that Rural Deanery and of the Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry of Hampstead, and shall not belong to or be a part of any other rural deanery or archdeaconry, nor be subject to the jurisdiction and authority of any other rural dean or archdeacon and that the said Rural Deanery of Holborn and each of the parishes or cures or churches comprised therein shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the archdeacon of the said Archdeaconry of London and to none other.

"And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other matter or thing with respect to the matters aforesaid or any of them by virtue of the said Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament."

And whereas Notices of the said Scheme have in accordance with the provisions of the secondly hereinbefore mentioned Act been transmitted to the archdeacons affected by the Scheme, that is to say, the Archdeacon of Hampstead, the Archdeacon of London, and the Archdeacon of Middlesex, and they have severally expressed their approval of the same.

And whereas the said Scheme has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts. And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of London.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the thirty-third and thirty-fourth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria,

chapter thirty-nine, and of the Acts therein mentioned, that is to say, the Act of the third and fourth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter one hundred and thirteen, the Act of the fourth and fifth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter thirty-nine, and the Act of the thirty-first and thirty-second years of Her said late Majesty, chapter one hundred and fourteen, duly prepared and laid before His Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the fifth day of February, in the year one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in pursuance of the Act of the thirty-third and thirty-fourth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter thirty-nine, and of the Acts therein mentioned, that is to say, the Act of the third and fourth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter one hundred and thirteen, the Act of the fourth and fifth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter thirty-nine, and the Act of the thirty-first and thirty-second years of Her said late Majesty, chapter one hundred and fourteen, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for effecting a transfer of the ownership of the advowson or perpetual right of patronage of and presentation to the church and benefice (hereinafter called 'the said benefice') of Gateforth, in the county of York and in the diocese of York.

"Whereas the advowson or perpetual right of patronage of and presentation to the said benefice of Gateforth is vested for an estate in fee simple in possession free from incumbrances in the Lord Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the city of Leeds (hereinafter called 'the said Corporation of Leeds'):

"And whereas the said Corporation of Leeds are desirous that the whole advowson or perpetual right of patronage of and presentation to the said benefice of Gateforth now vested in them as aforesaid should be transferred to and be vested in the Right Honourable and Most Reverend Cosmo Gordon, now Archbishop of York, and his successors in the same Archbishoprick.

"And whereas the said Cosmo Gordon, Archbishop of York, is willing to accept such transfer, and in token of such his willingness and also in token that the same transfer has that consent of the Bishop of the diocese which by the Acts in the hereinbefore mentioned Act recited or by some or one of them is made necessary, he, the said Cosmo Gordon, Archbishop of York, has executed this Scheme as hereinafter mentioned.

"And whereas the transfer of the patronage of the said benefice of Gateforth which is hereinbefore mentioned and hereinafter recommended and proposed will in our opinion tend to make better provision for the cure of souls in the parish or district in or in respect of which the right of patronage or advowson so recommended and proposed to be transferred as aforesaid arises or exists, that is to say, in the parish of Brayton.

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the said Corporation of Leeds (in testimony whereof they have affixed their corporate or common seal to this Scheme), and with the consent of the said Cosmo Gordon, Archbishop of York (in testimony whereof he has signed this Scheme and sealed the same with his Archiepiscopal seal), we, the said Ecclesias-
