(f) The range of hills and foreshore known as Blakeney Point, which area is coloured red on a map, similarly sealed and dated, and deposited with the Clerk of the County Council.

VII. The taking or destroying of the eggs of the following species of Wild Birds is prohibited throughout the Administrative County of Norfolk: —Bittern, Little Bittern, Great Bustard, Crossbill, Stone Curlew (Norfolk Plover, Thick-Knee), Great Crested Grebe or Loon, Harrier (all species), Hobby, Kingfisher, Wood Lark, Sand Martin, Owl (all species), Oyster Catcher (Sea Pie), Ringed Plover (Ringed Dotterel, Stone Runner), Ruff or Reeve, Tern or Sea Swallow (all species), Bearded Tit (Reedling or Reed Pheasant), Wild Duck and Teal (all species), Woodcock.
