FOR CALLING OUT MEN OF THE ROYAL NAVAL RESERVE AND ROYAL FLEET RESERVE,
AND OFFICERS AND MEN OF THE ROYAL NAVAL VOLUNTEER RESERVE.

WHEREAS by the fourth section of the Royal Naval Reserve (Volunteer) Act, 1859, it is enacted that it shall be lawful for Us on such occasions as We shall deem fit (the occasion being first communicated to Parliament if Parliament be sitting or declared in Council and notified by Proclamation if Parliament be not sitting or in being) to order
