38. To confer upon the Company all powers, rights, authorities, and privileges which are or may become necessary for carrying the powers of the Bill into effect, to vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would in any manner impede or interfere with the objects and purposes aforesaid, and to confer other rights and privileges.

39. To alter, amend, extend or repeal, and if thought fit to re-enact, with or without modification or alteration, all or some of the provisions of the several Acts hereinbefore mentioned or referred to, and of the Ormskirk Gaslight Act, 1853, the Ormskirk Gaslight Act, 1892, the Gas Companies (Standard Burner) (No. 2) Act, 1910, and any other Act relating to the Company or their undertaking.

And notice is hereby given, that a plan and duplicate thereof, showing the lands intended to be taken compulsorily under the powers of the Bill, and intended to be used for gas purposes, and for the purposes of a station or stations for generating electricity, together with a book of reference to such plans, and a map showing the boundaries of the proposed area of supply of electricity, and a copy of this Notice, as published in the London Gazette, will on or before the 30th day of November instant be deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Lancaster at his office at Preston, in the said county, and on or before the same day a copy of the said plan, map, and book of reference, and a copy of this Notice, published as aforesaid will be deposited with the Clerk of the Urban District Council of Ormskirk at his office at No. 22, Derby-street, Ormskirk aforesaid, and copies of the said map, showing the proposed area of electric supply, and of the said Notice, will also, on or before the said 30th day of November, 1914, be deposited with the Clerk of the Rural District Council of West Lancashire at his office at No. 2, Railway-road, Ormskirk aforesaid, and at the offices of the Board of Trade, 7, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W

And notice is hereby also given, that on or before the 17th day of December next printed copies of the Bill will be deposited in the Private Bill Office of the House of Commons.

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the present Session by the Metropolitan District Railway Company (hereinafter called "the Company") for an Act (hereinafter called "the intended Act") for the following or some of the following among other purposes (that is to say):—

To extend the time limited by the Metropolitan District Railway Act, 1912, for the compulsory purchase by the Company of the easement in or under certain lands authorized by and described in section 5 of that Act, and for the compulsory purchase by the London and South Western Railway Company of the lands required for the construction of the widenings of their Wimbledon and Fulham Railway authorized by and described in that Act.

To extend the time limited by the Metropolitan District Railway Act 1913, for the compulsory purchase by the Company of certain of the lands described in the Metropolitan District Railway Acts, 1910 and 1911, situate in the parish of St. George, Hanover-square, in the city and metropolitan borough of Westminster, and being the properties numbered 193, 195, 197, 199, 201 and 203, Victoria-street, and also to extend the time limited by the said Act of 1913 for the compulsory purchase by the Company of the lands in the parish of the city of London or some part thereof described in section 45 of the said Act of 1910.
