The KING has been graciously pleased to grant unto Thomas Clarke, of Eskmeals House, in the parish of Bootle, in the County of Cumberland, Esquire, in the Commission of the Peace for the said County, His Royal Licence and Authority that he may take and use the surnames of Butler and Cole in addition to and after that of Clarke, and that he may bear the Arms of Butler and Cole quarterly with those of his own family, and that such surname and Arms may in like manner be taken, borne and used by his issue. The said Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms and recorded in the College of Arms, otherwise the said Royal Licence to be void and of none effect.

And to command that the said Royal Concession and Declaration to be recorded in His Majesty's said College of Arms.

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The Right Honourable Reginald McKenna, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in virtue of the powers conferred on him by section 53 of the Explosives Act, 1875, has appointed Sergeant Patrick Dillon (No. 56911) and Sergeant Michael Queenan (No. 55840), of the Royal Irish Constabulary, to be Inspectors for Ireland under the said Act.
