

Regulation of Markets, &c., in Scheduled Area.

3. No sale of swine shall be held in any market, fairground or saleyard in the Scheduled Area described in the First Schedule hereto unless it is authorised by the Local Authority of the District under this Order (which authority the Local Authority are hereby empowered to grant), or is specially authorised under the principal Order or the Swine-Fever (Movement from Ireland) Order of 1904.

Effect of Licences, &c., granted under this Order.

4. No licence or declaration shall be required under the principal Order for the movement into a Scheduled Area, or along, over, or across a highway or thoroughfare in a Swine-Fever Infected Area, of swine which are being moved under and in accordance with a licence under this Order.

Forms.

5. The Forms referred to in this Order are the Forms set forth in the First Schedule to the principal Order, as modified by the Swine-Fever Order of 1911.

Saving of certain existing Local Orders.

6. Nothing in this Order shall affect the operation of any existing local Order declaring certain parts of the Scheduled Area to be a Swine-Fever Infected Area, or affect the operation of the Middlesex Piggeries (Swine-Fever) Order of 1912.

Revocation of Order.

7. The Order described in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby revoked.

Commencement.

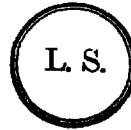
8. This Order shall come into operation on

the seventh day of June, nineteen hundred and fifteen.

Short Title, &c.

9. This Order may be cited as the BERKSHIRE, BUCKINGHAMSHIRE, MIDDLESEX, AND OXFORDSHIRE (SWINE-FEVER) ORDER OF 1915, and shall in relation to the Scheduled Area be read as part of the principal Order.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Scheduled Area.

An Area comprising:—

The administrative counties of Berks, Bucks, (except the parishes of *Linlade, Grove, Slapton, Edlesborough, Ivinghoe, Pitstone, Cheddington, Marsworth, and Mentmore*), Middlesex, and Oxford, and the county boroughs of Reading and Oxford; and

The parishes of Highclere, Burghclere (including its detached part), East Woodhay, Ashmansworth, Newtown, and Crux Easton, and the portions of the parishes of Kingsclere, Ecchinswell, and Sydmonton lying to the north of a line drawn along the northern fences of Freemantle Park Down, Cannon Heath Down, Watership Down, Sydmonton Down, and Hare Warren Down respectively, in the administrative county of Southampton.

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 27TH MAY 1915.)

(SWINE-FEVER INFECTED AREA.)

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894

to 1914, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Declaration of Swine-Fever Infected Area.

1. The Area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a Swine-Fever Infected area for the purposes of the Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1908.

Saving of Local Orders.

2. This Order shall not affect the movement of swine which are being moved to or from
