

*Exceptions from Restrictions.*

3. The restrictions of slaughter imposed by this Order shall not apply to—

(a) slaughter of an animal under the powers conferred by the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, or any Order made thereunder; or

(b) slaughter of an animal necessary or desirable on account of accidental injury to the animal or its illness; or

(c) slaughter of an animal if in the opinion of the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries the slaughter is desirable for any exceptional reason or purpose and the slaughter is authorised by a licence granted by that Board or an officer of that Board.

*Application of Order.*

4. This Order applies to England and Wales.

*Duration of Operation of Order.*

5. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-fourth day of June, nineteen hundred and fifteen, and cease to operate after the thirty-first day of August following, except in relation to proceedings for any offence committed on or before such last-mentioned date.

*Short Title.*

6. This Order may be cited as the **SLAUGHTER OF ANIMALS ORDER OF 1915.**

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction of a capital sum of five hundred pounds sterling, which has been paid to us, to be held by us for the permanent spiritual benefit of the parish of Madron with Morvah, in the county of Cornwall and in the diocese of Truro, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, grant, subject as hereinafter mentioned, to the Incumbent for the time being of the benefice of Madron with Morvah, to meet such benefaction, one yearly sum or stipend of fifteen pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the twenty-first day of April, in the year one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, and to be receivable in four equal portions, on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and the first day of November in each and every year; provided always, that the annual sum or stipend so granted by us to the Incumbent of the said benefice of Madron with Morvah shall be paid only upon the production to us on or after each of the said lastly mentioned days in each and every year of a certificate under the hand of the Bishop of the said diocese of Truro, that an Assistant Curate, duly licensed by such Bishop, has been employed within the parish of Madron with Morvah aforesaid during the quarter of the year then ended, and is in receipt of a salary after a rate of not less than one hundred and twenty pounds per annum; provided also, that such yearly sum or stipend shall continue payable as aforesaid so long only as may to us appear to be expedient under the circumstances from time to time affecting the said parish and benefice of Madron with Morvah.
