The Secretary of State for the Home Department hereby gives notice that a representation has been duly made to him by the owner, Captain Richard Granville Hylton Howard-Vyse, D.S.O., to the effect that a Fair has been held annually on the 24th day of June at Boughton Green, Northampton, and that it would be for the convenience and advantage of the public that the said Fair should be abolished.

On the 4th day of October, 1915, the Secretary of State will take such representation into consideration, and any person who may desire to object to the abolition of the Fair should intimate his objections to the Secretary of State before that day.
